

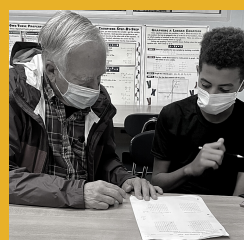


By the Numbers 2021-2022

148

Nearly 150 Kindergarten to 12th graders succeeded academically through our after-school tutoring programs. More than 70% of our middle & high schoolers ended the year with an A or B average.



135

"Summer slide" and COVID learning loss were kicked to the curb, as 135 K-12 students kept up with reading, math, bible study, and more at our Summer Learning Program. Not only that, but they had some summer field trip fun, too!

43 middle & high school boys & girls are engaged in long-term 1:1 or small group mentoring relationships with a Jericho mentor, who helps them navigate life, build their faith in Christ, and reach their full potential to live a life of excellence.



460

More than 100 families received essentials - meat, dairy, fresh produce, bakery and non-perishable staples - every week through our food pantry. With each family numbering 3-6 people, we provide food for about 460 individuals weekly.

New in 2022, we fed students who don't have enough to eat when school isn't providing free breakfast and lunch. We prepared 75 Weekender Bags every week, each containing six small meals, for students in need.

Our Samaritan Health Center saw approximately 1,200 pediatric patients this year, providing physicals, immunizations, and sick care to the underserved, uninsured community.

Too often, families that struggle with food insecurity can't celebrate Thanksgiving with a turkey and all the fixings. This past Thanksgiving, we provided full meals to 150 families, up from 100 the year before!

Having a Christmas gift under the tree may be a given to most, but that's not the case for everyone. This Christmas we provided 257 gifts for some of the families (kids and parents) we serve.
